The National Maritime Safety Authority (NMSA) is responsible for promoting, complying with and maintaining world class maritime safety standards in Papua New Guinea consistent with legislation and commitments under National Legislation and International Conventions in order to facilitate a safe, efficient and environmentally responsible shipping sector for stakeholders in government, industry and the community. Under the mandate, NMSA ensures a fully functioning and effective network of aids to navigation; availability of high quality and up to date navigational charts; that vessels meet the safety standards required by law and international commitments; ensuring seafarers' competency through vigilant examination and certification, and coordinating maritime responses to distress calls and monitoring and controlling ship-sourced pollution. The NMSA now wishes to fill the following positions:

Manager Ship Survey & Inspection (Readvertised and is open to PNG and non-PNG citizens)

Job Objective

To plan, monitor and manage all activities of Ship Survey & Inspection Department. Responsible for the effective and efficient management and regulation of the coastal shipping industry, oversee ship surveys, Port State Control inspections and security checks under the provisions of the International Ship and Port Security Code. Oversee conduct of examination for seagoing qualification, safe manning of vessels, licensing and registration of ships; and implement provisions of the fifteen (15) International Maritime Organization (IMO) conventions and protocols to which PNG is signatory.

Principal Accountabilities and Services Standards

Among the core accountabilities the successful incumbent will:

Ensure Department and NMSA is kept abreast on the status of relevant IMO convention implementation and recommend amendments to current legislation where necessary; ensure all inspection is consistently complying with NMSA Quality Procedure Manual; establishes, implements and enforces guidelines as per PNG Merchant Shipping Act; ensure departmental business objectives are effectively planned, implemented and achieved; ensure certification of technical service providers for maritime industry in line with International Safety Management (ISM) code; assist Executive Manager Maritime Operations in casualty investigation and marine inquiries and provide report and recommendations as required; plan and conduct in liaison with Qualifications Department to ensure all oral examinations for Master and Engineer meet Standard of Training, Certification and Watch-keeping for seafarers (STCW)

Person Specification and Experiences

The successful person for this position must meet the following requirements:

Skills

Excellent leadership skills; advance communication skills; excellent report writing and presentation skills; ability to mentor and manage.

Knowledge

Demonstrated and sound knowledge and understanding of national and international maritime legislations and practices; thorough knowledge of Port State Inspections (PSI) and Flag State Inspections (FSI) and ship surveys; Merchant Shipping Act; Pollution Prevention Act; Maritime Labour Convention 2006.

Qualifications

Minimum qualification is Master Class 1/Engineer Class 1

Experience

Minimum of 15 years as a senior ships inspector or 10 years working as a class surveyor or having relevant managerial experience in a reputable shipping company or shipbuilding/repair yard would be advantageous.
