# UPGRADE OF KIMBE BAY AtoN STRUCTURES.

The National Maritime Safety Authority (NMSA) is the State Entity Responsible for Maintaining and Raising Standards of Maritime Safety, Prevent and Control Marine Pollution from Ship Source and Coordinate Marine Search and Rescue Operations.

The Authority is embarking on maintenance of all marine Aids to Navigation (AtoN) sites and structures in and around PNG waters. The Authority now invites reputable contractors to express their interest to replace two existing AtoN's structures at Kimbe Port (Kimbe N0.2 and N0.5) with bigger structures with platforms to improve by human eye and vessel radar. The existing AtoNs are small structures coupled with limited visibility and capacity for additional accessories installation for visual and radar visibility.

Interested contractors are required to submit Expression of Interest (Eoi) addressing our requirements stipulated on the Terms of Reference (ToR) uploaded on the website.
